To the 29 countries, where Lectrotab distributors are currently active, we are privileged to add one more; welcome to Turtle Marine Inc, in Nagasaki, Japan. Turtle's initial order is ready for shipment and awaits their release. With Turtle on board, the Lectrotab product is now available from Iceland to Australia and from England to Turkey to Japan. We note that this coverage leaves a little gap around latitude 75° east, which runs through India, so we put a sticky note on President Bush's desk, asking him to include us in his trade talks with India and Pakistan this week. Since it is not appropriate for him to keep the sales commission, we have suggested he deposit it in the general fund to help offset the trade deficit.

The new Oval controls, the SETR-50, gray, and the SETR-51, black, which are programmable and multi-station, and supercedes the earlier ovals, are on the shelf. The installation manual is on the web site and ordering is simple; just say Gray Oval or Black Oval.

Wireless update: the Lectrotab wireless system design is complete and prototypes are in the works. The wireless helm control will look like the oval and will have all of the Oval features, including multi-station capability, but will be slightly smaller, and will have one added feature; a button at the lower center. Tap the button once, at any time, and the tabs will fully retract. Tap it twice, any time, and the tabs will fully deploy. When you think about it, this is a nifty feature!

Alloy tab update: the Lectrotab alloy tab testing and designs are complete and prototypes are in process. We can't disclose details at this time but we promise an awesome product.
