We now have the actual molded cover piece for the new black “Oval” control and are very pleased with the way it looks. The all black look is very strong on a white or black console surface. A color photo will be on the new Lectrotab website.

The multi-station “Oval” design is complete as follows: Overall, it will be identical in look and function as the standard “Oval” with the seven spade connectors and mounting studs unchanged. But, in addition, there will be a small two pin communications socket, on the back, in the upper left hand corner, just above the + power spade terminal. In a multi-station installation, install all the “Ovals” you wish. Connect the main power and the actuators to any one of the “Ovals” as usual. Next, connect switched or “auxiliary” power to each “Oval”. Then, using one or more two conductor wires, with the appropriate plug on each end, connect all the “Ovals” together using the 2 pin communications sockets. Remember: the main power and actuators connect to only one of the “Oval” controls. When done, the tabs can be controlled by any “Oval” and the tab position will be displayed by all “Ovals”. Display dimming will be controlled by local conditions at each “Oval”.
